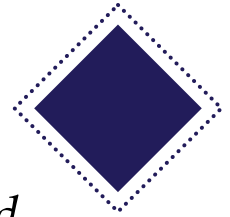

AGEING

Secondary: nine to twelve months post-blend ageing in new, fine grain French oak casks

TASTING NOTES

Nose: hints of cereal, mild spices, honey and white flowers

Palate: round, with flavors of yellow fruit, cooked apple and gingerbread

Finish: long and fresh

The first and only 100% French Triple Malt Whisky, crafted from the three best Single Malt whiskies from around the country (North, East and Southwest). Three different distilleries and three different stills. The final, post-blend ageing takes place in Bellevoye's Charente cellars near Cognac.

ABV: 40%

AGEING

Primary: three to seven years in French oak casks

Secondary: six months post-blend ageing in *Cru Classé* Sauternes casks

TASTING NOTES

Nose: hints of dried fruits mingled with hints of spices and acacia honey

Palate: delicate and silky, with flavors of ripe and juicy fruit

Finish: light, with notes of almond and hazelnut

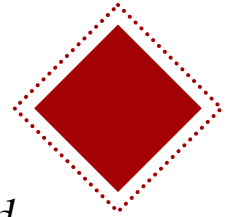

ABV: 43%

AGEING

Primary: five to ten years in French oak casks

Secondary: six months post-blend ageing in Saint-Émilion Grand Cru casks

TASTING NOTES

Nose: hints of crème brûlée and early autumn walnuts

Palate: balanced yet generous, with suggestions of generous Medjool dates

Finish: long and flavorful, with hints of fine spices and brown sugar

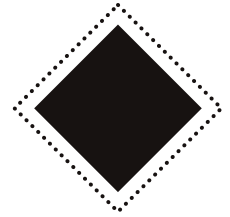

ABV: 43%

AGEING

Primary: five to ten years in French oak casks

Secondary: nine to twelve months post-blend ageing in new French oak casks

TASTING NOTES

Nose: empyreumatic notes that evoke ash, toast and mocha

Palate: rich and mellow, with a harmonious balance

Finish: long and persistent, with typical peaty aromas

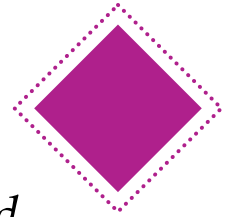

ABV: 43%

AGEING

Primary: three to seven years in French oak casks

Secondary: post-blend ageing in old plum liqueur French oak casks

TASTING NOTES

Nose: plum is the salient feature in this fruit bowl of cherry plums, apricots, peaches and pears

Palate: succulent and fruity

Finish: long and persistent, with notes of almonds and stewed fruit

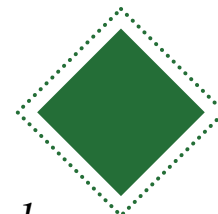

ABOUT

The first and only 100% French Triple Malt Whisky, crafted from the three best Single Malt whiskies from around the country (North, East and Southwest). Three different distilleries and three different stills. The final, post-blend ageing takes place in Bellevoye's Charente cellars near Cognac.

ABV: 43%

AGEING

Primary: three to seven years in French oak casks

Secondary: nine to twelve months post-blend ageing in 40-year-old Calvados casks

TASTING NOTES

Nose: slightly smoky malt melds with the aroma of baked apples and subtle spicy hints of cinnamon and nutmeg

Palate: full and robust, with a gentle saline freshness

Finish: long and lush with lasting aromas of precious woods
