# THE CLASSIC COLLECTION - DECANTER

Since 1905, the *Tesseron* family have been renowned for producing some of the finest and oldest *Grande Champagne* cognac in the appellation. They were kept as a trade secret up until 2003, when the *Tesseron*'s decided to commercialize a collection of four cognacs under their family name, called: *The Classic Collection*.

The Classic Collection has recently been given a new look and now comes in the 'Tesseron' decanter together with a new more dynamic packaging.

The Classic Collection is presented under 'Lot' numbers, which historically was the trade term used to identify a blend. Using this traditional method of identification and delving into the cellars of their legendary collection of age-old Grande Champagne reserves, these four numbered 'Lot' cognacs reflect the lifetimes' work of four generations of the Tesseron family as refined cognac distillers. Each expression illustrates the art and craftsmanship of their heritage.

This remarkable cognac range vary in age from more than a decade old, with the classic *Lot no.90 XO Ovation* and span three further generations culminating in the *Lot no.29 XO Exception*. This series provides a unique opportunity to experience the difference in taste between each of the generations and their remarkable qualities developed over the years of ageing.




