SINCE THE EARLY 19TH CENTURY, the name Paul Jaboulet Aîné has been synonymous with quality in the Rhône. In early 2006, the Frey family bought Jaboulet and implemented sweeping changes to return Jaboulet to the summit of quality Rhône producers. Winemaking stresses severe selection; dramatically lower yields, long and steady fermentations and aging in newer oak barrels. The wines are rich and dense, with remarkable balance and finesse: Rhône grapes in full song. All Domaine wines have been certified organic since 2016.

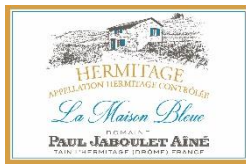


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Hermitage La Chapelle 2018

- 100% Syrah from 40 to 60 year old vines
- Made from the best terroirs of Hermitage (le Méal, les Bessards and les Roucoules).

Hermitage La Maison Bleue 2018

- 100% Syrah from 40 to 60 year old vines.

Hermitage Le Chevalier de Sterimberg 2018

- 70% Marsanne / 30% Roussanne from 30 to 40 year old vines.
- The Chapel of Saint-Christophe was built by the knight Gaspard de Sterimberg in 1235.
- Biodynamic since 2017.

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Crozes-Hermitage Domaine de Thalabert 2018

- 100% Syrah from 40 to 60 year old vines.
- The oldest Domaine of the Crozes-Hermitage appellation, one of Paul Jaboulet Aîné's properties since 1834.

Crozes-Hermitage La Mule Blanche 2018

- 50% Marsanne / 50% Roussanne from 40 to 60 year old vines
